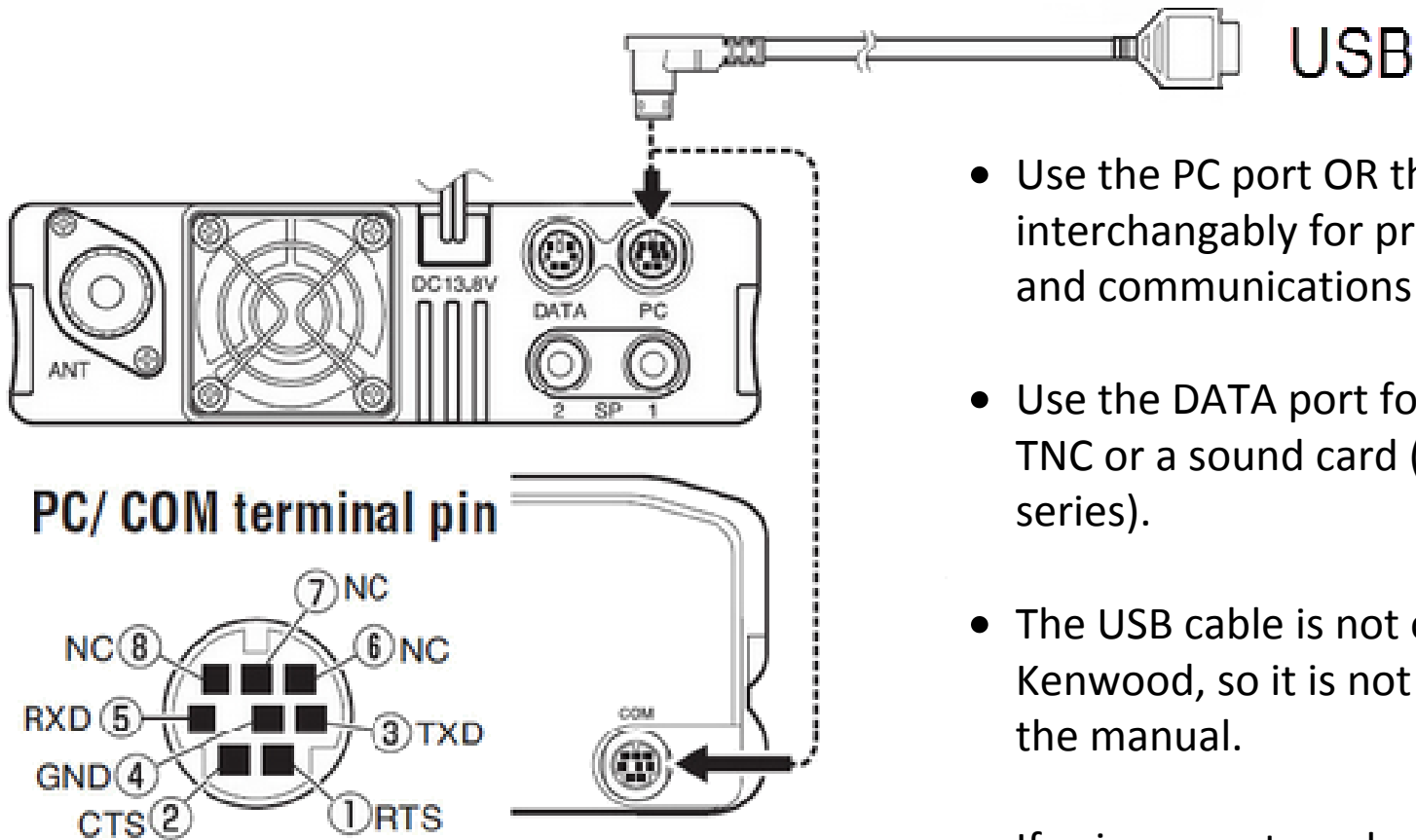
Kenwood TM-D710G FM Dual Bander

Basic Setup

- Connections for Control Panel, Radio, and Mic are labelled. Pay attention to labels, because they can be improperly connected.
- The microphone connects to the body of the Radio, not the Control Panel!
- If using a PowerPole distribution box, make sure you are plugging into the 20-amp fuse (YELLOW)!
- Use of an external speaker is recommended.
- For extra credit, download a copy of the Kenwood manual from our website and store it on your laptop!

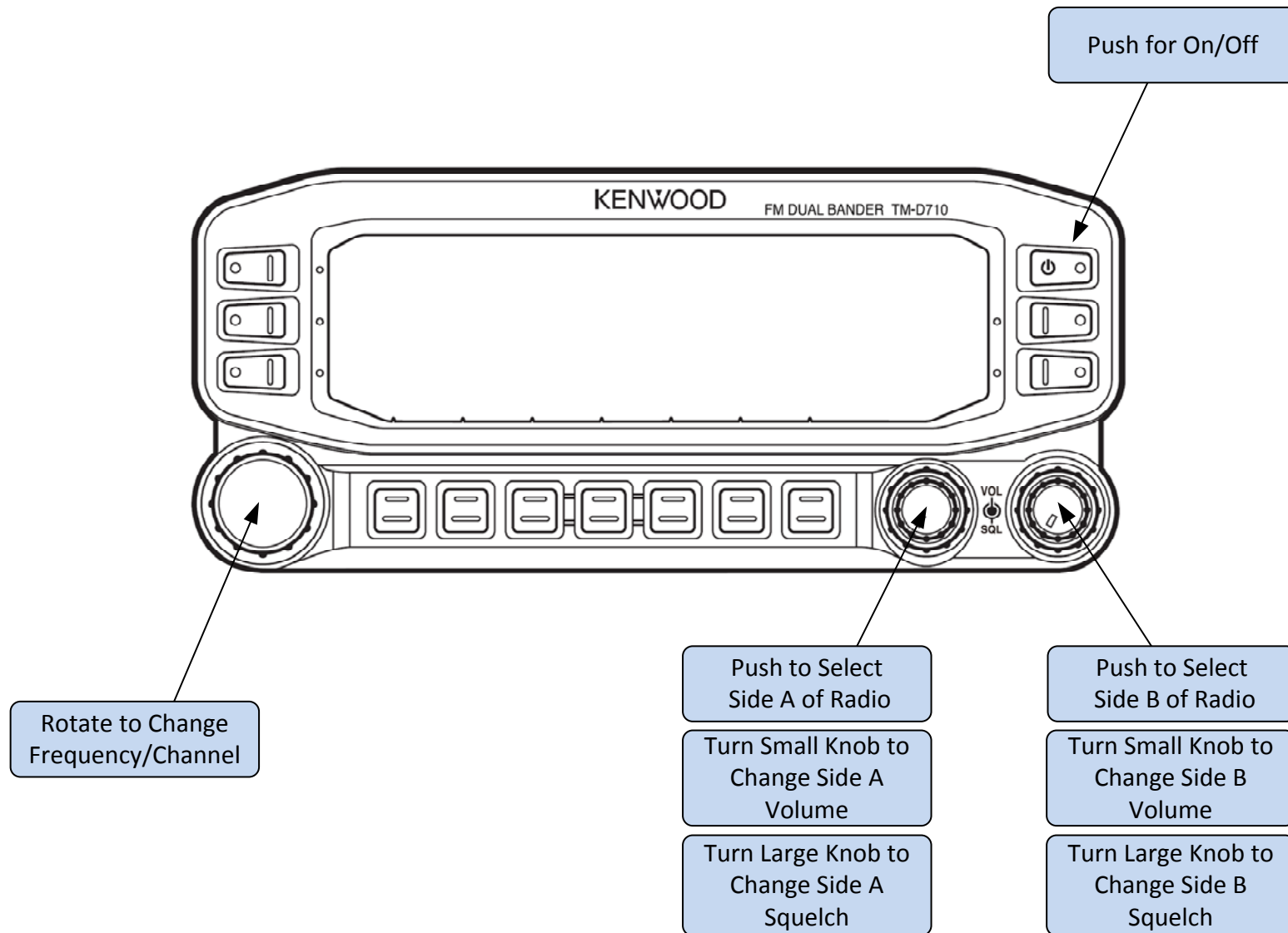
Computer Cable Connection



- Use the PC port OR the COM port interchangeably for programming and communications with laptop.
- Use the DATA port for an external TNC or a sound card (VARA DRA-series).
- The USB cable is not offered by Kenwood, so it is not described in the manual.
- If using an external speaker, use SP1.

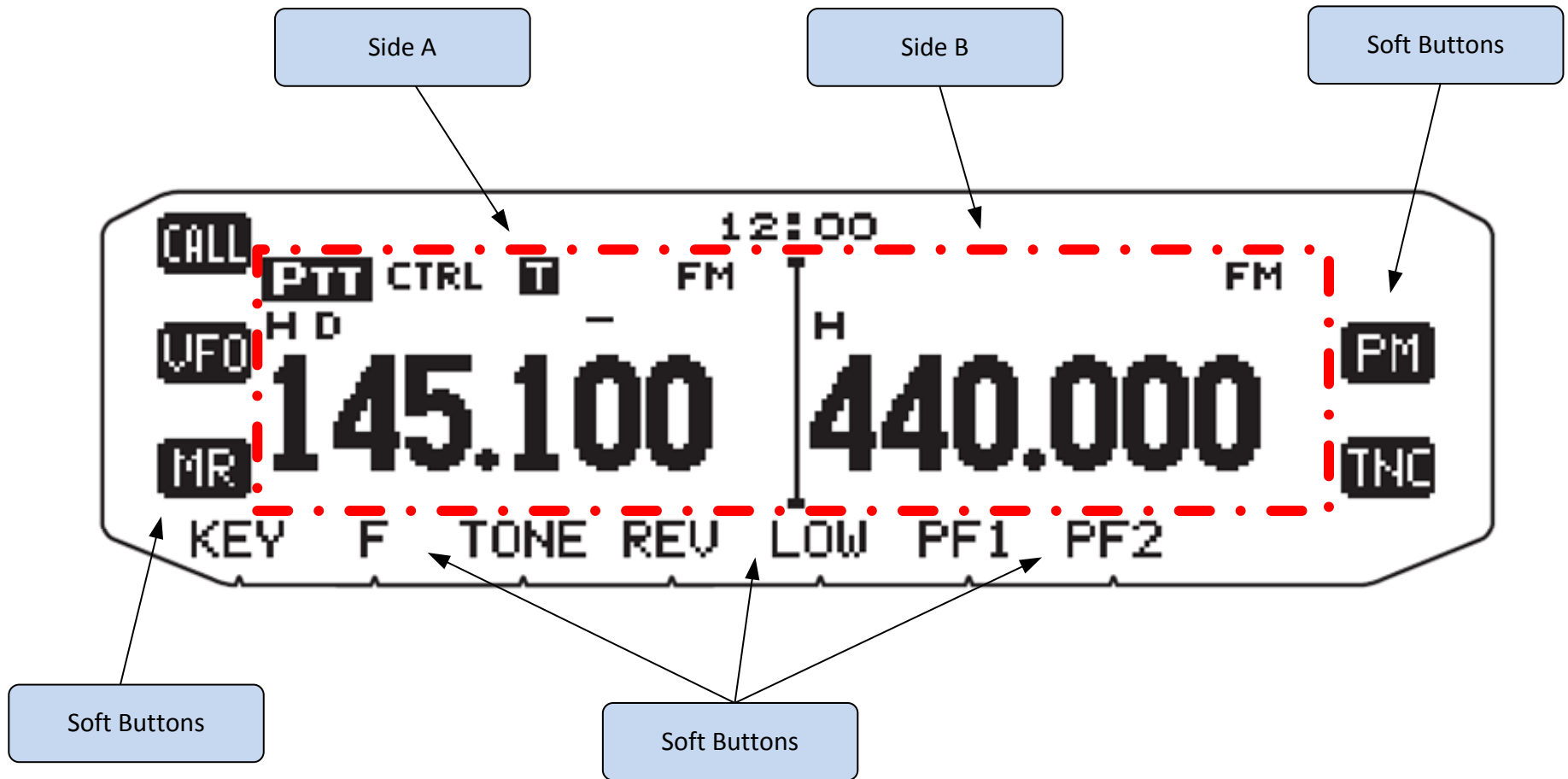

Fixed-Function Controls



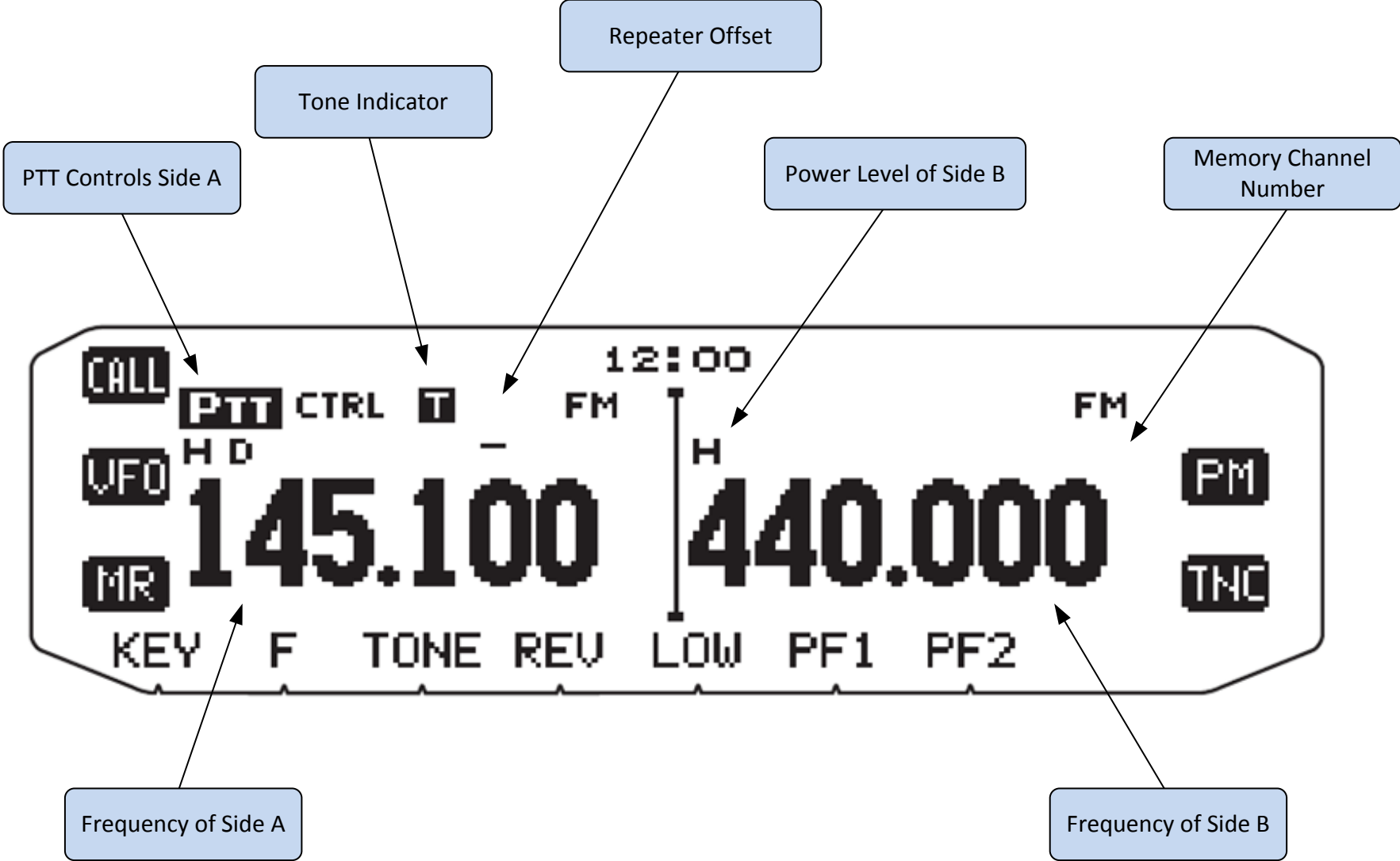

Display Sections



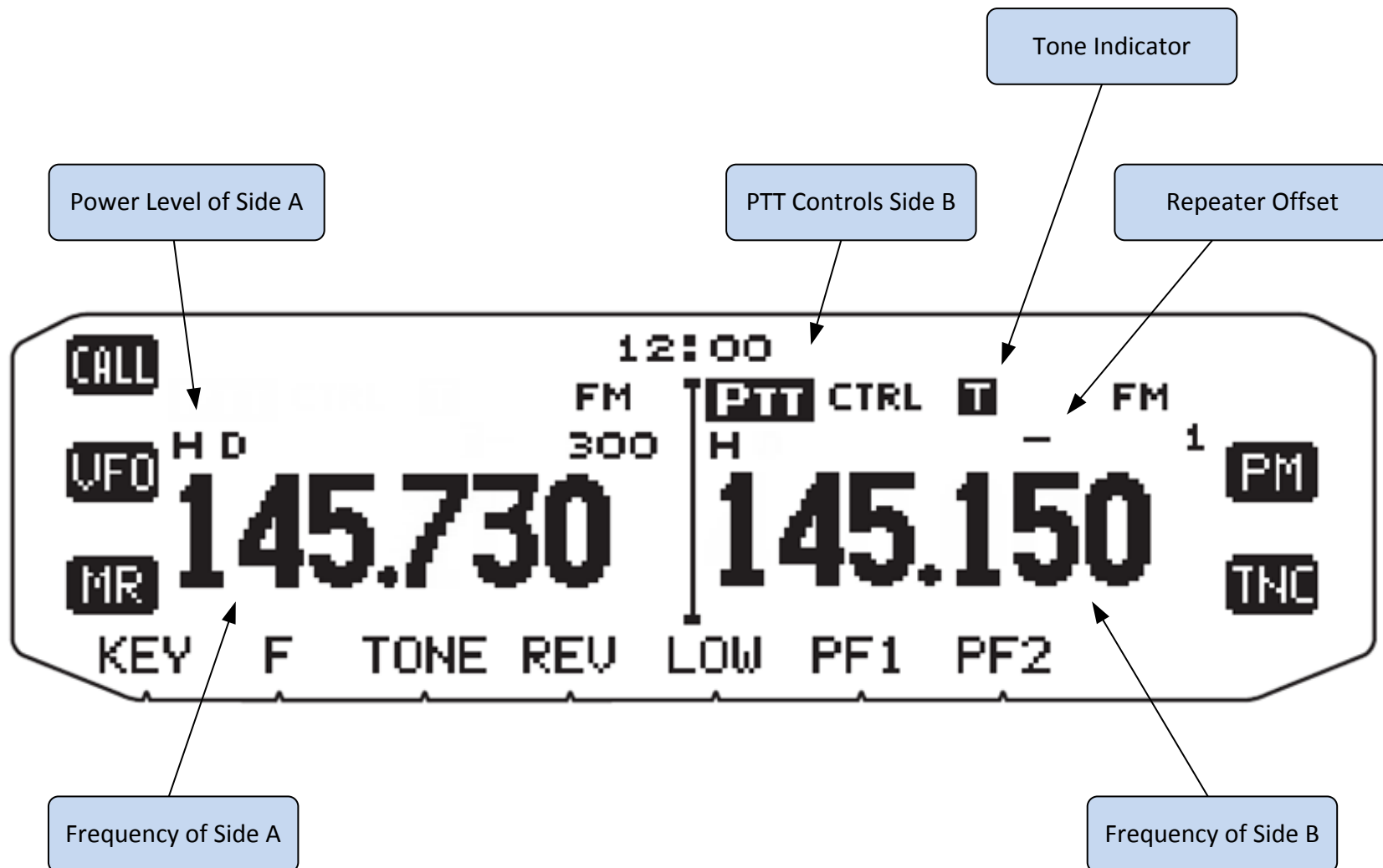
